Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills

Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation

October 3rd & 4th, 2009

This course is for all adults connected with the Cub Scout Program: Cubmasters, Asst. Cubmasters, Committee Members, Den Leaders, and Parents.

In the Outdoor Webelos Leader Skills portion, you will learn many useful tips to teaching your Webelos the skills they need outdoors as well as ways to help prepare them for Boy Scouts. Completing this course will also certify you to lead Webelos only Den campouts.

In the Baloo Training, you will learn how to plan a campout for your Cub Scout Pack. This includes setting up camp, cooking meals, First Aid, planning age appropriate outdoor activities, learning about health and safety guidelines and much more. **The Boy Scouts of America National Policy is that there must be a Baloo (certified adult) present at any pack-organized campout.**

This is your opportunity to take part in an enjoyable outdoor learning experience and discover what the outing in Scouting is all about!

The training will take place at Lake Tigator on the Avondale Scout Ranch. You will need to be in camp by 8:00am Saturday morning and you will be dismissed around 12:00 noon Sunday.

NOTE: This is an adult leader course – no children or Cub Scouts will be present.

UNIFORM: Proper field uniform is required for all leaders.

COST: \$30.00 per person - this will cover cost of instruction supplies, meals for Saturday night, snacks, Sunday morning breakfast.

WHAT TO BRING: You will need a bag lunch for Saturday noon. All camping supplies (tent, sleeping bag, lantern, flashlight, etc.) lawn chair and pen & paper.
